Running Time: Three to four minutes

Props: None

ELISE: I can still see her lying there in the bassinette wrapped up in pink blankets. She was...(beginning to cry) ...so perfect.

ELISE: I'm sorry. I shouldn't be so upset. I should be strong. After all, we still have her...and, no matter how many problems...she's still our little girl.

RON: That's right. She is.
