Synopsis: Three teens, thinking out loud, express their inability and hesitancy about giving to missions and outreach causes...until they encounter some needs face to face.

Running Time: Two minutes

Props:

checkbook

paycheck

mission tour shirt or other indication of recent mission tour

#1: *(holding his checkbook)* What? Me give money to missions? You're kidding, right? I mean, if I gave every dime in my account right now it wouldn't feed a gerbil for a week.

#2: *(holding his paycheck)* See this? My first paycheck! Look at it! I think I'll frame it. No, first I'll cash it and then I'll frame it. Mine! All mine!!!

#3: *(holding a mission tour shirt)* Hey, I went on mission tour this year...even gave my testimony once. And you want me to give money, too?

#4: Somebody told me about a crisis center where I could go for food and clothing. Does anybody know anything about it?
