**Theme:** Senior Adults and change

**Scripture References:** Proverbs 17:6; Isaiah 46:4; Psalm 112:1-2; Philippians 1:6

**Characters:** One (either gender)

A grandma or a grandpa

**Tone:** Sweet

**Synopsis:** A loving grandparent (with grandchild in arms) speaks about how things used to be, but though times have changed, God has not.

**Running Time:** Two minutes

**Set:** None

**Props:**

Baby wrapped in blanket (a doll would be fine)

*(Grandma or Grandpa enters carrying a “baby” that is wrapped up in a blanket.*

*Grandma is humming “Jesus Loves Me”. She or he speaks to the baby)*
