Theme: Spiritual Growth/Comfort Zones

Scripture References: Deuteronomy 4:9; Colossians 2:6-8; Ephesians 4:11-12; 2 Thessalonians 2:15; 2 Timothy 2:15; 2 Peter 3:18

Characters: Two (either gender)

Tone: Light

Synopsis: A believer is actually defining his (or her) spiritual comfort zone when another believer questions this action.

Running Time: Two minutes

Set: None

Props:

Rope (4-5 feet long)

(Scene opens as #1 is placing a long piece of rope on the floor in the form of a circle.

Enter #2, watching for awhile then speaks...)

#2: So...what are you doing?

#1: I'm defining my spiritual discovery zone.

#2: I see. Kind of small and confining, isn't it?

#1: Yeah. But...look at this. I can change the shape of the zone. I can make a square, a triangle, or...even a parallelogram.

#2: But there's still a small area you have to stay in, no matter what the shape.

#1: So?

#2: So...what if there's something over here...say, just outside the zone that God wants to teach you.
