**Running Time:** Two minutes

**Set:** None

**Props:**

Broom

Other cleaning supplies (optional)

Doll(s); children

*(off stage narrator, on stage character)*

*(woman enters holding baby or two with one hand and a broom in the other; frantically she tries to juggle them both)*

NARRATOR: There was a old woman who lived in a shoe...

*(annoyed look from woman)*

Excuse me...wrong story!

There was a young woman who lived in a house...

How's that?

*(a-okay sign from woman)(woman continues with pantomime that illustrates her busyness and her longings for more time with other moms and with God)*
